Guidelines and Policies for Submission of Abstracts

- The closing date for abstract submissions will be advised once the new symposium dates are announced. Submissions are welcome in the meantime.
- It is a condition of acceptance that all presenters must be registered delegates and have paid the conference registration fee, at least for the day of their presentation. The Symposium is not able to provide funding for presenters.
- Presenters must be available to present on *any* of the symposium days, as assigned by the Organising Committee.
- Your abstract, if accepted, will appear in its full form in the Program Book, which will be distributed at the symposium in the delegate satchels.
- All abstracts must contain original work.
- The presenting author must submit the abstract.
- All abstracts must be prepared according to the guidelines provided. Incomplete or incorrect submissions will be returned to the author and must be resubmitted immediately in the correct format to be considered for inclusion in the program.
- It is the responsibility of the presenting author to ensure that the abstract is submitted correctly and received by the Conference Managers by the deadline. The Conference Managers will not be held responsible for abstract submissions not received.
- Abstracts must be prepared using the template available for download on the conference website. Abstracts must be 300 words or less (including references) and must not contain images, figures or tables.
